What is Poet's Walk?

The Poet's Walk project is the construction of the site for the home of the James Joyce Brick at 412 Jasper Street. It will be a grand entrance to Eve's Garden and Greenhouse and the Emerald Street Garden. A grand brick archway will be constructed with brick pillars, iron fencing, and gates. The walkway itself will be bricks and will honor our favorite poets and authors.

What is the James Joyce Brick?

Brendan Kilty purchased the rubble to the James Joyce House in Dublin. The bricks from this home are scattered around the world to create "Joyce Seats of Learning." Existing sites include Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, and Melbourne, Australia.

How can I participate?

You can participate in the Poet's Walk Project by making a \$100 contribution. For your \$100 donation, a brick will be inscribed with the name of your favorite poet or author and included in the walkway.
